

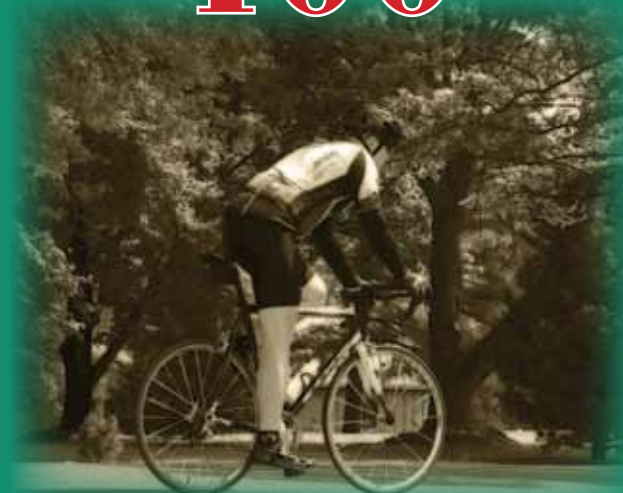

The Rotary Club of Burlington is offering a fully supported 25, 50, 64 and 100 mile bike tour. Cruise down beautiful, lightly traveled back roads in Burlington and Monmouth Counties. From rolling hills and horse farms to the solitude of the Pines, this ride is one of the most unique and beautiful rides in New Jersey. All routes have well stocked rest/food stops, SAG support and lunch at the end of the ride.

### Ride Information

The ride starts and ends at the Burlington Township High School, Jacksonville Rd. and Fountain Ave., Burlington, NJ

- Registration opens at 7:00 am.
- 100 mile riders, please be on the road by 8:00am.
- 50 and 64 mile riders, please be on the road by 9:30am.
- 25 mile riders, please be on the road by 11:00am.
- All rider services end by 4:30pm.
- Riders under 18 must be supervised by an adult.
- Every route has a cue sheet and is well marked.

**Cost: \$35.00 for pre-registration**  
**\$40.00 on the day of the ride**

## Directions to Burlington Twp High School

### From the North Jersey and New York

Take the NJ Turnpike S to exit 5, or I-295 S to exit 47. Get on Rt 541 North. Go 3 miles (Tpke) or 1.25 miles (295) and turn Right on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, High School is on the right.

### From the Delaware and South Jersey

Take the NJ Turnpike N to exit 5, or I-295 N to exit 47. Get on Rt 541 North. Go 3 miles (Tpke) or 1.25 miles (295) and turn Right on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, High School is on the right.

### From PA and the West

*Burlington Bristol Bridge* - Turn left on Rt 130 N. Go 1/2 mile and turn Right on Rt 541. Go .75 mile and turn Left on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, the High School is on the right.

*Tacony Palmyra Bridge* - Take Rt 73 South to Rt 130 N. Go 11.5 Miles and turn Right on Rt 541 S. Go .75 mile and turn Left on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, the High School is on the right.

*Ben Franklin Bridge* - Take Rt 30 to Rt 130 N. Go 16 miles and turn Right on Rt 541. Go 3/4 mile and turn Left on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, the High School is on the right.

*Walt Whitman Bridge* - Get on I-295 N to exit 47. Get on Rt 541 N. Go 1.25 miles and turn Right on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, High School is on the right.

*From the PA Turnpike Bridge* - At the first exit in NJ take Rt 130 South. Go 4.25 miles and turn Left on Rt 541. Go .75 mile and turn Left on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, the High School is on the right.

### From the East

Get on Rt 541 North. After you pass the entrance to the NJ Turnpike follow Go 3 miles and turn Right on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, the High School is on your right.

### From the Shore

Rt 537 to Woodlane Road (.7 mile after crossing Rt. 206) turn Right. Go .7 mile and turn Right on Rt 541. Go 4.5 Miles and turn Right on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, the High School is on your right.

Rt 72 to Rt 70 East. Go 8 Miles to Rt 206 North. Go 8 miles and turn Left on Woodlane Road. Go 3.75 miles and turn Right on Rt 541. Go 4.5 Miles and turn Right on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, the High School is on your right.

AC Expressway or Rt 30. Go to Rt 54 or 206 North. From the intersection of Rt 30, go 10 miles and turn Left on Rt 541. Go 23.5 miles and turn Right on Fountain Ave. Go 2 blocks, the High School is on your right.
